PRESS STATEMENTS ON THE STATUS OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT AND THE NEW GOVERNMENT

The Kenya National Union of Nurses wish to congratulate His Excellencies, the President of the Republic of Kenya Hon. Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta , Deputy President William Samoei Ruto, the Excellencies all the newly elected Governors and those who have successfully defended their position, and other leaders who were elected in the country. As you settle down in your respective positions, we wish to reiterate that the KNUN remain a very impartial trade union.

Coming at a time when the nurses strike is in its (3rd) third month, we implore upon the Head of state and all the government functionaries who include the newly elected governors to prioritize the Nurses Strike which was occasioned by failure to sign their negotiated CBA which will be beneficial to all the stakeholders.

We equally want to assure nurses that the union in consultation with Ministry of Health, Nursing Council of Kenya, SRC and COG are working on the job evaluation exercise to ensure that her members shall not be disadvantaged by the recently concluded SRC Job Evaluation report.

We also call upon the County Public Service Boards through the COG to be sensitive to the process and deliberate with the union in good faith towards addressing the CBA issues with finality.

Finally we reiterate that the union is still open for dialogue with the relevant authorities in this regard.
